



## Why is it different to other outdoor cleaning products?

Wet and Forget can be used on ANY outside surface as it is almost PH neutral. Other outdoor cleaning products are limited to certain types of surfaces due to their aggressive chemical content. What's more, each time it rains it reactivates a small percentage of the ingredients, which helps to keep the affected surface clean while destroying any new contaminating spores. This is why once a surface is clean it will remain so for up to a year. Spray annually and there is unlikely to be any recontamination.

## Are there any other benefits?

The normal method used to clean outdoor surfaces would be to pressure wash the surfaces, but this can strip paint of surfaces, remove grouting and sand, and could ultimately make a surface dangerous to walk on because it becomes unstable. Using Wet and Forget can avoid these problems as it has a gentle cleaning action that works over time.

## How often should I use Wet and Forget?

Wet and Forget is likely to last for up to a year. However, reapply at the first sign of recontamination.

**How do I use Wet and Forget?**

For light contamination and algae, mix five parts water to one part Wet and Forget in a pump out garden sprayer. With black mould and lichen, use three parts water to one part Wet and forget.

**How much coverage will 7 litres of Wet and Forget achieve?**

Up to 420 square meters.

**Can I use Wet and Forget all year round?**

You certainly can, even in winter. All you need is a dry day and for it to remain dry for 3 to 5 hours after spraying.
